Why use the Authorized King James Version of the bible (KJV)

God created a plan for his word to come to life in the heart of each believer by renewing the knowledge of himself intimately through the flesh of his word (Joh 1:14, "the Word became flesh").

In the right season of time 400 years ago, he placed a desire in a king (whose name was James) to create one readable bible out of four original languages from the old and new testaments.

The authority his kingship given through his name (James means Jacob in Hebrew which means supplanter) allowed him to replace and supersede the existing published word with the old and new testament languages from the original scripts. He did this by commissioning 47 biblical scholars to create one absolutely accurate language of God's word in a new book.

God honoured King James' authority to testify of God himself from one side of creation (old) to the other (new) which made God's word accessible and readable for all (hence; the authorized KJV, accessibility of "The Word made flesh")

God's standard of measurement comes in a Shakespearean format. Layers of revelatory imagery are manifested in us as we grow and change in the flesh of his word. This may seem foolish to many of us who have adopted other versions of bibles that have since been published and re-wiritten; yet, the Authorized KJV is proving to be the book of life that keeps growing into the entirety of all the scriptures coming together to bring forth light to the mysteries of these last days (words of spirit and life, Joh 6:63). This is because of the consistency in the interpretation of the original script. These are "rhema" and "logos" words that are derived from the four original languages (Aramaic, Hebrew, Greek and Latin). "Rhema" words are of the spirit of the word, and Logos is the flesh of the word. These words are specific in the authorized KJV and cannot be found in another translation of the bible.

As the scripture in James speaks ...gifts that enlighten us, are from the Father of lights above; they are without inconsistencies and are not marked by the shadow of time, but are revealed in the authorized KJV, Jas 1:17). "But whose looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed." Jas 1:25

How do we know this? by searching out, studying, reading and growing in the Word of God (Pet 1:20) Jesus Christ our Lord, becomes the revelation of our regeneration by the word of life. "Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not **knowing** the scriptures, nor the power of God." Mt 22:29 (9:4)

Jacob in the role of king, preserves the twelve tribes (Jas 1:1) to represent the remnant (of Jacob's house) in these last days. Jacob by interpretation means "heel catcher" in english; it is derived from supplanter and supplanter means to supersede and to replace. King James fulfilled his name in his season of time by accomplishing God's plan for salvation in the regeneration of his scripture. (Heb 1:1-2)
